



What else did Hebrews want to see? What else do we want to see?

Yahoshua 3:5 And Yahoshua said to the people, "Purify yourselves, for tomorrow Yahweh will do wonders among you."

Yahoshua 3:15 and as those who bore the ark came to the Jordan, and the feet of the kohanim who bore the ark dipped in the edge of the water (for the Jordan overflows all its banks during the whole time of harvest), 16 that the waters which came down from upstream stood still, and rose in a heap very far away at Adam, the city that is beside Zaretan. So the waters that went down into the Sea of the Arabah, the Salt Sea, failed, and were cut off; and the people crossed over opposite Jericho. 17 Then the kohanim who bore the ark of the covenant of Yahweh stood firm on dry ground in the midst of the Jordan.

This event, among other events, gave to Yisraeli people the opportunity to experience the berajot given by Yahweh. Still, many of them decided to follow the evil, they decided to be proud, selfish, and that behavior was the one that guide them to the Diaspora narrated on the Torah.

What else do we want to see?

Yahweh has given us all the material things that we wanted and that we asked for. But over all those things he called us banin and benot Yahweh; he gave us the hatsalá which is free and for the eternity. **So, what else do we want to see?**

If we really want to see extraordinary things that are worth to see we must participate of the call that Yahweh has given to us. This in order for many around the world to know the Real Name of the creator of the Universe, **that name is Yahweh**, and for all those to have the opportunity to pronounce it.

Please do not pronounce these words: "if I had more Yahweh, I will be able to give more, because what I have right now is not enough. That way I will be able to give enough for the rest of the world to know your Name."
