



What is the height of your walls?

I am really impressed about this verse and I will like to highlight something that nowadays became an obstacle in our life style in Yahweh. Yom by yom we find really high walls that are difficult for us to climb. The verse that I am mentioning is ***Yahoshua (Joshua) 6:20 So the people shouted when the kohanim blew the shofarot. And it happened when the people heard the sound of the shofarot, and the people shouted with a great shout, that the wall fell down flat. Then the people went up into the city, every man straight before him, and they took the city.***

Most of the time, people from the occidental hemisphere believe that the walls from Yerijo mentioned on the Torah were 9 feet tall. Actually they were 18 feet wide and 90 feet tall.

It is mentioned on the Torah too on ***Ibrim (Hebrews) 11:30 By faith the walls of Jericho fell down after they were encircled for seven days.***



Shofarot.

It is really amazing what happened there that yom. It is for sure that the walls did not fell down due to the shofarot or the shouting of the people. It was the power of Yahweh that made the walls fell down due to the emunah and the obedience people form Yisrael.
