



## What is your real nature?

There is a "Tale" that says that there was a frog that was willing to cross the river. A scorpion that was really close to the frog saw her willing to cross the river and asked the frog to take it to the other side because it needed to cross the river, too. The scorpion asked the frog to carry it over its back. The frog refused to do it at the beginning because the frog knew that the scorpion was a traitor and could sting it. The scorpion insisted and was able to convince the frog to take it to the other side. It got on the frog's back and they started to cross the river; when they got to the other riverbank the scorpion sting the frog on the back. At the moment the frog felt the sting on its back and started to sink in the water the frog asked the scorpion: Why did you sting me if I helped you as you requested? So the scorpion answered back to the frog: it is my nature, I cannot change it. What is the lesson on this tale? Nobody can betray its own nature.

**This tale give us a great teaching and lesson that we can apply to human beings that are not under Yahwéh's will but under Ha-Satan's will. These are some of the characteristics:**

- You help some people but when you do not expect it they betray you as the scorpion did.
- There are some people that will bit you the hand when you extend it to help them.
- There are some people that do not want orientation or to be helped by others. They want to get everything for free and still they will complaint about the things that they have received from us.
- There are some people that will never say thank you does not matter how much you give them, they will think only on their own nature and will be selfish in Ha-Satan.
- You have met for sure people that promised you the heaven and the earth but they do not give a thing, they just expect for the right moment to hurt you.

The tale is so close to the reality that for sure you have lived it before with someone, but with a lot of pain. At this point you will be asking yourself: Are all human beings like this? What about the change in Yahwéh?

The scorpion will never change its nature, a human being for himself or herself will never be able to change. Only with the help of the Ruaj HaKodesh the person will be able to change, otherwise they will have the characteristics mentioned before. I will like to mention some verses from the Torá that will clarify this situation:

### **The nature that never changes and it is as the one from the scorpion on the Tale:**

***Yohanán (John) 8:44 You are of your progenitor Ha-Satan, and the desires of your progenitor you want to do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own resources, for he is a liar and the progenitor of it.***

When we believe that we have changed we will realize that we are bound to the sins and that they way that we will always be, where the bad things do not bother us, they just please us, this is a warranty as before that you keep being like the scorpion under Ha-Satan's will and following his rules.

Every time the things get difficult and complicated you pull out your Sting and do your job, the bad thing, it does not matter your progenitors, friends, work, relatives, couple, etc. this is the moment where the person become selfish and the nature takes control.

**Yahwéh promised to change the nature on his banin (sons) and benot (daughters) "for the love of His name":**

At the moment that Yahwéh called us there must be a positive change in regards our sinful nature in Ha-Satan. This change does not take place because we want to but because Yahwéh put the necessity on us to make the change, a positive change in emunah that will make a difference yom by yom in Yahwéh. It says it says in the Torá in ***Qorintyahim Bet (2 Corinthians) 3:17-18, 17 Now Yahshúa is the Ruaj; and where the Ruaj of Yahshúa is, there is liberty. 18 But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the kavód of Yahshúa, are being transformed into the same image from kavód to kavód, just as by the Ruaj of the Yahwéh.***

It says also in the Torá ***Romans 5:5 Now hope does not disappoint, because the love of Yahwéh has been poured out in our hearts by the Ruaj HaKodesh who was given to us. As well as in Romans 5:9-10, 9 Much more then, having now been justified by His dam (blood), we shall be saved from wrath through Him. 10 For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to Yahwéh through the death of His Ben, much more, having been reconciled, we shall have hatsalá (be saved) by His life.***

If someone just to please his or her nature in Ha-Satan decides to hurt a ben or bat Yahwéh, he or she will have to face later fatal consequences in his or her life. As we can read in the Torá in Romans 12:19 Beloved, do not avenge yourselves, but rather give place to wrath; for it is written, "Vengeance is Mine, I will repay," says Yahwéh.

I confess that the promise given in this verse is a truth and confess that Yahwéh will take care personally of those scorpions willing to harm the elect ones in Yahwéh for the eternal hatsalá.

On the other hand, there are many that have taken the name of Yahwéh just as something casual but the change does not happen on them, these that use the name lightly and without the necessary respect will be punished as mentioned in the Torá in ***Kefa Bet (2 Peter) 2:20-22, 20 For if, after they have escaped the pollutions of the world through the knowledge of the Elohim and Matsil (Savior) Yahshúa Ha Mashiah, they are again entangled in them and overcome, the latter end is worse for them than the beginning. 21 For it would have been better for them not to have known the way of righteousness, than having known it, to turn from the kadosh (holy) miztvá (commandment) delivered to them. 22 But it has happened to them according to the true proverb: "A dog returns to his own vomit," and, "a sow, having washed, to her wallowing in the mire."***
