



## When we want to fight alone

Most of us have seen those documentaries on television about how the Lion attacks its prey. Lions tend to choose old, sick, or newborn animals because they have no chance to escape or to struggle to save their lives. They are easy preys. Besides that, lions wait for that type of preys to show up in order to start the attack. Lions separate the prey from the rest of the animal on the pack or the herd, that way the rest of the animals will not try to save the prey and will die easily. The Torá says on *Kefa Alef (1 Peter) 5:8* ***Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour. This is exactly a description of Ha-Satan's behavior.***



There are some verses on the Torá that talk about the construction of the Miqdash (Temple) from the people of Yisrael and the enemies that were trying to avoid the construction of it. Really important point mentioned on the verses is that we always need to work together and avoid trying to be The Lone Ranger. Yahweh says that together we will succeed but contrary to this Ha-Satan says that by ourselves we will succeed. What will be the best lesson to learn from the Yisraeli people and the construction of the Miqdash? Let's read the verses on *Nejemyah (Nehemiah) 18* ***Every one of the builders had his sword girded at his side as he built. And the one who sounded the trumpet was beside me. 19 Then I said to the nobles, the rulers, and the rest of the people, "The work is great and extensive, and we are separated far from one another on the wall. 20 Wherever you hear the sound of the trumpet, rally to us there. Our God will fight for us." 21 So we labored in the work, and half of the men held the spears from daybreak until the stars appeared. 22 At the same time I also said to the people, "Let each man and his servant stay at night in Jerusalem, that they may be our guard by night and a working party by day." 23***

***So neither I, my brethren, my servants, nor the men of the guard who followed me took off our clothes, except that everyone took them off for washing.***

**We need to note something that probably we are leaving behind as Yahweh's people:**

1. *The construction of the Miqdash should exemplify the type of life that we should have in Yahweh.*
2. *Our enemy is Ha-Satan.*
3. *We need to be always ready to fight the enemy back with our sword in the ruaj that is the Torá.*
4. *Our purpose, necessities, and our enemy are the same, even when we are not together.*
5. *We need to be always aware and ready, from the sunrise to the sunset.*
6. *Our Elohim is always the same and if we ask him for help He will fight for us.*
7. *No human being is exempt from Ha-Satan attacks but the ones is Yahweh have someone to fight for us, if we allow it.*

It is really important to mention on this topic that our enemy will come to us on different ways. Still, we will be able to recognize him if we want to do it when He tries to separate us from the group and from our principles through different means like liars, fake people, adulators, the ones who defame, the ones who like to gossip, and eloquent people. All of them will bring with them evil distractions or they will talk wisely in order to contradict the Torá and we will believe them if we are not strong enough. Let get together as a group on Yahweh and He will give us his strength.
